Purpose: To fill the Field Office Representative collateral duty position on the New Hampshire Civil Rights Advisory Committee (CRAC).



The New Hampshire Civil Rights Advisory Committee is recruiting to fill the Field Office Representative collateral duty positions on the New Hampshire Civil Rights Advisory Committee.

- New Hampshire's Field Office Representative serves as a regular CRAC member.
- Appointed to three-year terms by the State Conservationist.
- They are authorized to spend up to 10% of their time on CRAC activities as a co-lateral duty.
- All New Hampshire NRCS employees are encouraged to apply.
- Committee members attend quarterly meetings and promote/contribute to Committee activities.
- The State Conservationist makes the final selection for the Committee and if there are no volunteers, the State Conservationist will appoint. Someone to the position.
